

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(DIDCOT AREA) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 202***

Oxfordshire County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Didcot Area) (Speed Limits) Order 202* and shall come into force on the day of 202*.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order
3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 30 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 40 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
5. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 50 miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
6. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
7. The Oxfordshire County Council (Didcot Area) (Speed Limits) Order 2021 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE 1

Part A

20mph Speed Limit:

1)	Oxford Crescent	The whole road for its entire length
2)	Copse View	for its entire length
3)	Oakend Lea	for its entire length

SCHEDULE 1

Part B

20mph Speed Zone:

- 1.) The whole length of every road within Great Western Park Northern Neighbourhood and District Neighbourhood leading outwards to the following points:
 - a) Sir Frank Williams Avenue (northern end) to a point 5 metres north of its junction with the northern junction to Ash Way
 - b) Sir Frank Williams Avenue (southern end) to a point 20 metres north of its junction with the B4493 Didcot Road

- c) Holly Lane to a point 23 metres north of its junction with the B4493 Didcot Road.

2.) The whole length of every road within the Dudcote Field development, leading outwards to the following point:

a)	Dudcote Field	its junction with the A4130 Milton Heights to Didcot Road
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SCHEDULE 1
Part C

20mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road within Ladygrove (north & east of the railway line) leading outwards to the following points:

a)	Avon Way	its junction with the A4130
b)	Mersey Way	its junction with the A4130
c)	Trent Road	its junction with Abingdon Road/Upperway Furlong roundabout
d)	Upperway Furlong	its junction with Abingdon Road/Trent Road roundabout
e)	London Drive	its junction with A4130 Abingdon Road
f)	North Bush Furlong	its junction with A4130 Abingdon Road
g)	Tamar Way	its junction with the A4130 Abingdon Road
h)	Cow Lane	its junction with Hitchcock Way

The whole length of every road within the Willowbrook Park residential development (north of the A4130 perimeter road) leading outwards to the following points:

a)	Franklin Gardens	its junction with the A4130
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SCHEDULE 2

30mph Speed Limit:

The whole length of every road in the town of Didcot excluding the A4130 Milton Heights to Didcot Road and the A4130 Didcot Northern Perimeter Road, extending to the following points:

- 1) B4493 Wantage Road the parish boundary, a point 190 metres west of its junction with Slade Road
- 2) B4493 Foxhall Road its roundabout junction with Station Road
- 3) Station Road its roundabout junction with Foxhall Road
- 4) B4016 Abingdon Road a point 196 metres north of its junction with the A4130
- 5) A4130 Didcot to Wallingford Road a point 168 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road leading to South Moreton
- 6) Park Road a point 231 metres south of its junction with

Portway

- 7) Sir Frank Williams Avenue (Great Western Park) From a point 55 metres south of its junction with the A4130, southwards (partially in the Parish of Harwell) to a point 5 metres north of its junction with the northern junction to Ash Way.

SCHEDULE 3

40mph Speed Limit:

B4493 Didcot town:

- 1) B4493 Didcot: From its roundabout junction with the A4130 and Mendip Heights, Didcot, eastwards To its roundabout junction with Station Road / Foxhall Road, Didcot for a distance of 990 metres
- 2) A4130 Didcot From its roundabout junction with the B4493 and Mendip Heights, westwards
- 3) Milton Road From its RBT junction with the A4130, westwards to the Sutton Courtenay parish boundary, a distance of 630 metres
- 4) The A4130 Didcot – Wallingford road in the parishes of South Moreton and North Moreton
- A4130 Hadden Hill, South Moreton From a point 168 metres west of its junction with the unnamed road leading to South Moreton, north-eastwards to a point 150 metres east of the centre of the western arm of its junction with Long Wittenham Road, North Moreton.

SCHEDULE 4

50mph Speed Limit:

- 1) The A4130 Didcot Northern Perimeter Road:
- A4130 Didcot From its roundabout junction with the B4493 and Mendip Heights, north and eastwards to its junction with the B4016 Lady Grove.
- 2) A4130 Didcot - Wallingford road, in the parishes of North Morton and Brightwell cum Sotwell
- A4130 Hadden Hill / High Road From a point 150 metres east of the centre of the western arm of its junction with Long Wittenham Road to a point 155 metres northwest of its junction with Slade End.
